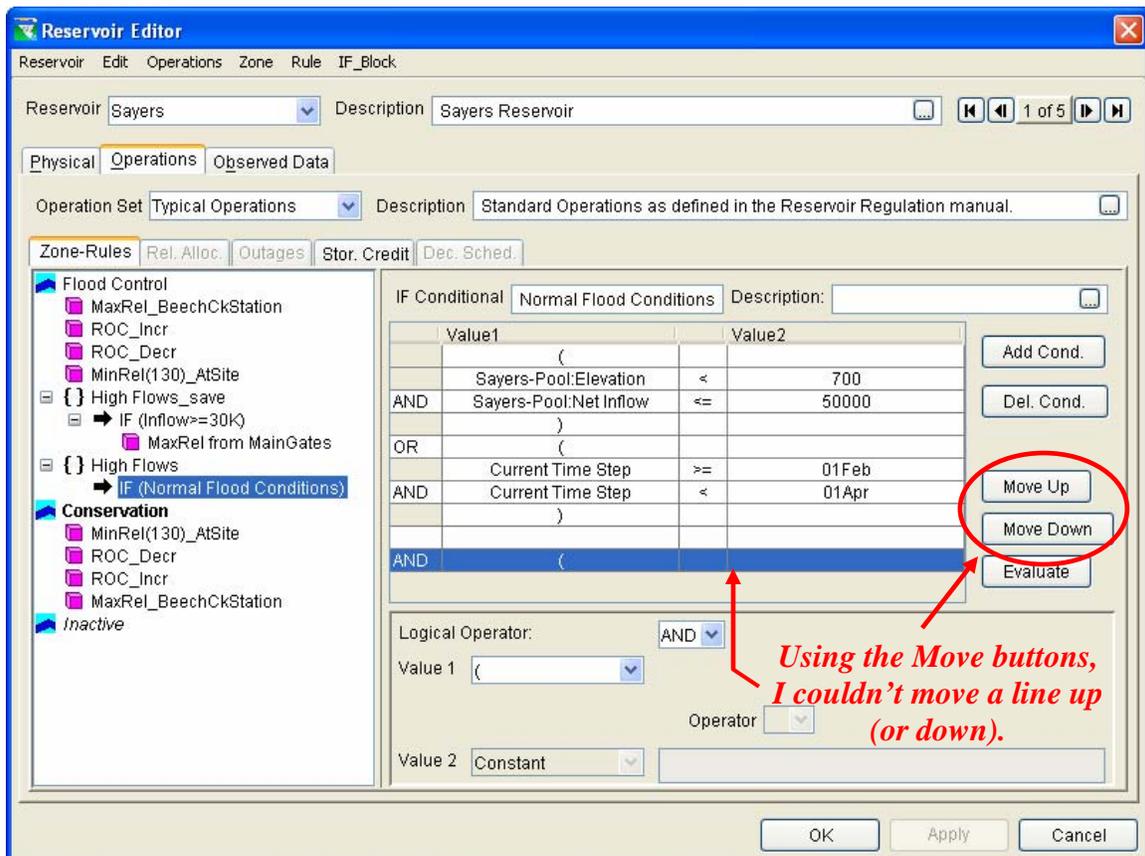

4. Problem Description

Reservoir editor, IF_Block Conditional Test editor: Move Up and Move Down buttons generate error messages in the console log.



I was creating a complex conditional statement for an If-block in my operation set. I added several condition lines (which appended to the bottom). I wanted them elsewhere so I clicked on the Move Up button. Nothing happened. So I tried the Move Down button on an existing line. Still nothing happened. I checked the Console log from the Tools menu from the main display area (map window) and found the following error messages:

Error finding method moveUp in class hec.rss.client.ConditionalPanel  
Error finding method moveDown in class hec.rss.client.ConditionalPanel
```

5. Steps to Reproduce

- 1) Add an IF_Block.
- 2) Add conditional lines.
- 3) Try moving lines up and/or down using the buttons.
- 4) Check the console log.

6. The Watershed

I have replicated this behavior in other watersheds so it is not unique to the data/model.
